Hooptown, USA- The follow up list to July's A.A.U. Preview rounds out 50+1 players to watch this month and presents players that you may or may not know about. Some have offers and are on the verge of gathering many more offers in the next few weeks.

6'7" 2011 wing Kiram York (Del Valle in TX.) Spiece ATX 17u- Versatile, long, and an Inside Prep Sports' Top 75 player in 2011 with mid-major plus offers as of May.

6'8" 2011 power forward Percy Gibson (Detroit Southeastern in MI.) Team Detroit 17u- Gibson is a powerful lefty who can play above the rim and take over games in the post as he has proven throughout the spring AAU season.

6'7" 2011 power forward George Fant (Warren Central in KY.) All-Ohio Red 17u- The tools are there as he has nice size, athleticism, toughness, and diversity from 15' and in.

6'4" 2011 point guard Darean Jones (Ben Smith in NC.) D1 Greyhounds 17u- He changes speeds well and go left or right and is efficient on either side of the basket with a solid pull-up jumper.

6'2" 2011 wing Jamie Crockett (Crete-Monee in IL.) Mac Irvin Fire 17u- Crockett is a solid athlete who knocked down three after three in a couple of tournaments this spring.

6'1" 2011 point guard Anthony Fields (Quality Education in NC.) D1 Sports 17u- His game has developed over the past couple of years where he's more about efficiency rather than flash. He's super quick and does a solid job creating for one of the nation's best in Quincy Miller.

6'8" 2011 power forward JJ Panoske (Brodhead in WI.) Roberts Bros. 17u- Panoske has mid-major offers now with bigger schools lurking and waiting for July 6th. He's a solid face up four-man.

6'8" 2011 center Alonzo Murphy (Schenly in PA.) BSA 17u- Murphy's a big body who's not an above the rim player but he's strong enough to come in immediately and play on the defensive end.

6'3" 2011 guard TJ Buchanan (Kalamazoo Central in MI.) King James 17u- The versatile wing/guard is strong enough to play on the D1 level now and he's physical. He's a mid-major plus lock and possible high major player with an improved jumper.

6'1" 2011 point guard Kris Davis (Detroit Cass Tech in MI.) Detroit Fire 17u- Michigan's most underrated player has a mid-major offer now and with a solid July that number will grow.

5'11" 2011 point guard Brian Sullivan (Upper Arlington in OH.) CBIZ 17u- Sullivan has mid-major offers and he's a pass first point guard who can knock down jumpers from the perimeter and the mid-range.

6'6" 2011 small forward Ryan Sabin (Byron Center in MI.) Hurricanes Grady 17u- Sabin plays hard, finishes with authority in transition, and a decent scorer in the half-court.

5'8" 2011 combo guard George Goodman (Saginaw Buena Vista in MI.) REACH Legends 17u- He's super quick and a solid athlete who would make a great combo guard for programs that aren't afraid of small guards.

6'6" 2011 power forward Javontae Hughes (Kalamazoo Loy Norrix in MI.) Camp Darryl 17u- Hughes is athletic with decent size and far from a finished product. He can step out and spot up from 19' and in who could be a steal for a low-MM with red-shirt options.

6'10" 2012 power forward Willie Cauley (Spearville in KS.) Speice MoKan 16u- Cauley's long, athletic and shows a lot of promise a times when the little guys around him decide to get him the ball.

6'5" 2012 wing Brandon Morris (Millergrove in GA.) Southern Kings 16u- This lefty is extremely active with athleticism to boot. He's bouncy and a solid scorer from the mid-range and in.

6'8" 2012 forward Matt Costello (Bay City Western in MI.) Team Pride-McCormick 17u- Think Evan Smotrycz. He has great grades, great kid, and great work ethic.

6'5" 2012 shooting guard Anton Wilson (Flint Carman-Ainsworth) Team Pride 16u- Wilson is one of Michigan's best shooters with a pure stroke. He's long and athletic who will have many offers after his guard skills improve.

6'1" 2012 point guard Cameron Fowler (University of Detroit-Jesuit in MI.) REACH Legends 16u- He has great grades, plays hard, scores, and looks to create for others. He's a solid athlete who finishes above the rim and has nice body control.

6'4" 2012 wing Marques Mondy (Forest Hills Central in MI.) Mustangs 16u- Mondy is a nice one-on-one player who can get hot from the perimeter. He's long and a very nice athlete.

6'9" 2012 power forward Davontae Williams (Lincoln Park in PA.) Crons-Cavanaugh 17u- Williams is raw but long and athletic. He's only played organized basketball for a few years and upside is his friend.

6'1" 2012 point guard Anthony "Sap" Clemons (Lansing Sexton in MI.) Mustangs 16u- Clemons is a strong point guard who does a lot of things to get wins.
